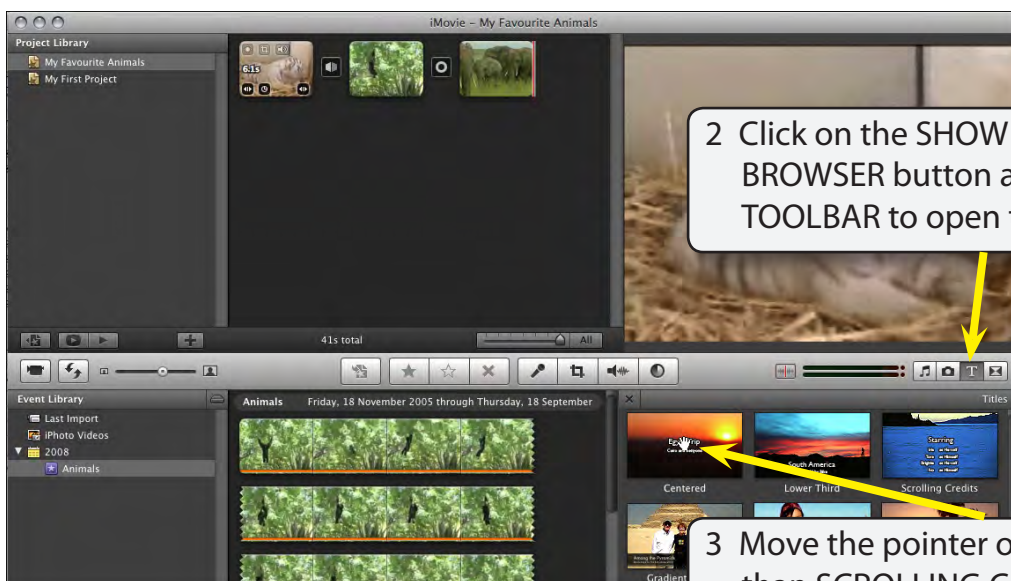


Adding Titles to Movie Clips

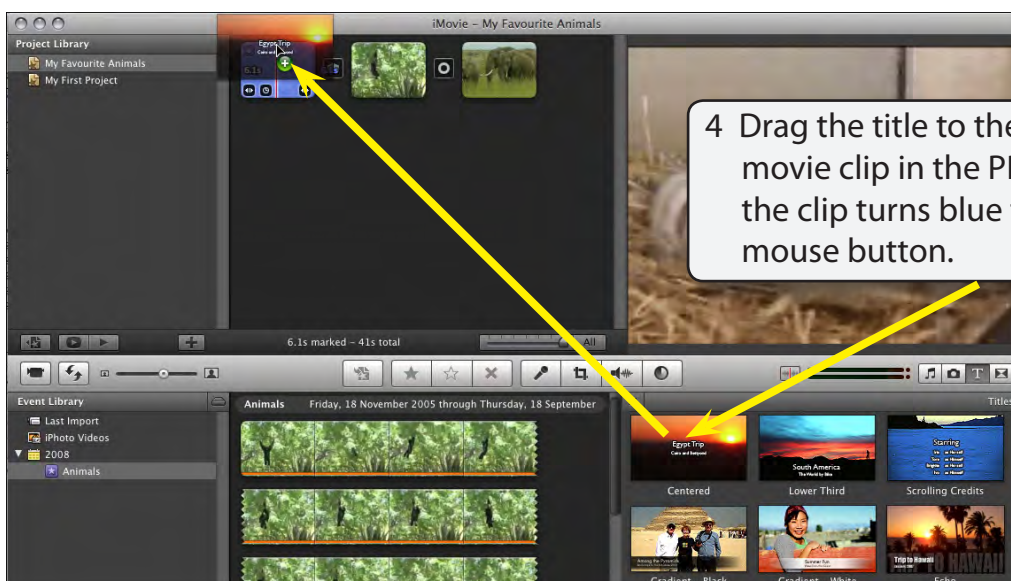
Titles can be added over frames or on a black background. Let's add an introduction title over part of the first movie clip and closing credits over a black background at the end of the movie

Adding Titles Over Frames

- 1 Your MY FAVOURITE ANIMALS project should be open.



- 3 Move the pointer over a title (other than SCROLLING CREDITS) until the pointer changes to a hand.



NOTE: If you release the mouse button with the green line next to a movie clip, the title is inserted next to the movie clip rather than over it.

Changing the Text

The text needs to be altered to match the movie.



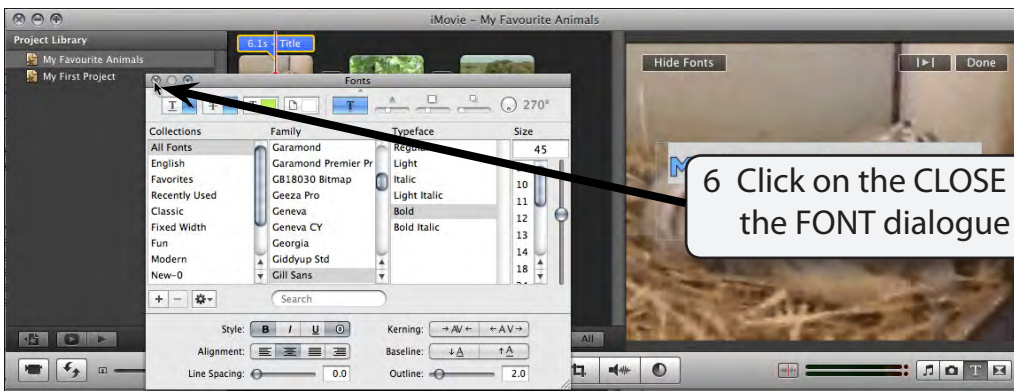
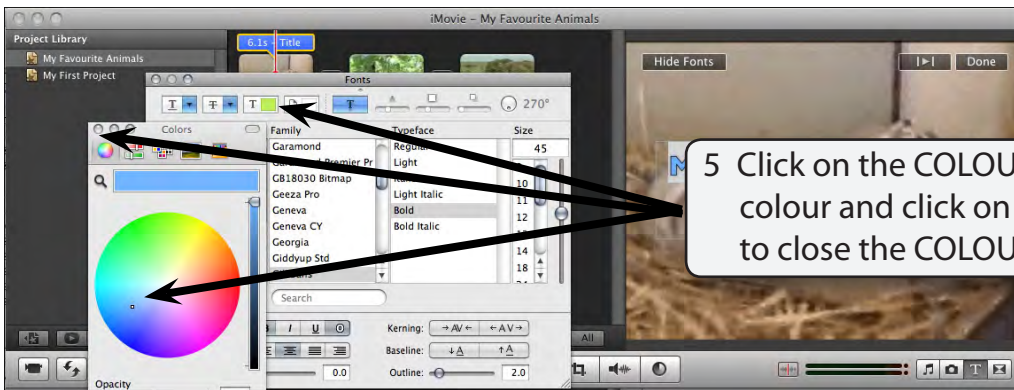
1 In the VIEWER highlight TITLE TEXT HERE and enter:
My Favourite Animals

2 You can change the appearance of the text.

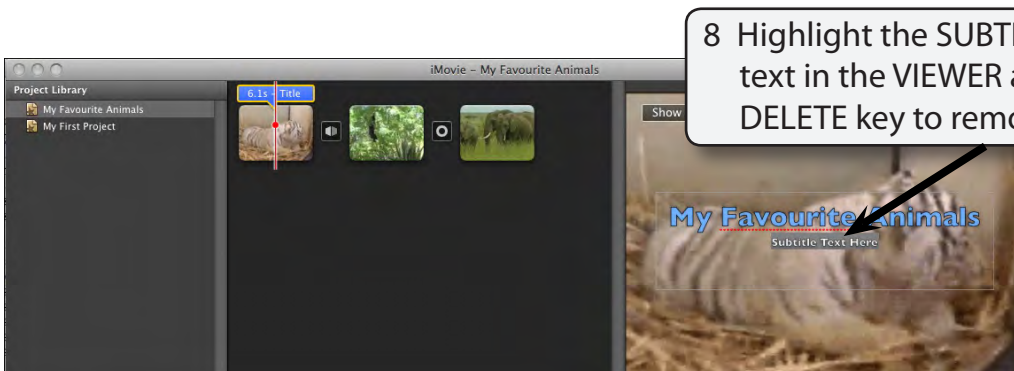


3 Highlight MY FAVOURITE ANIMALS in the VIEWER and click on the SHOW FONT button.

4 The FONTS dialogue box is opened, set the FONT SIZE bar to 45 point.



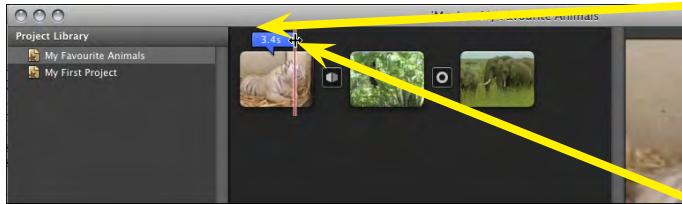
7 In this case the sub-title text is not required.



9 Play the movie from the beginning to see the effect of the title.

Changing the Duration of the Title

The time that the title stays on the screen can be adjusted.



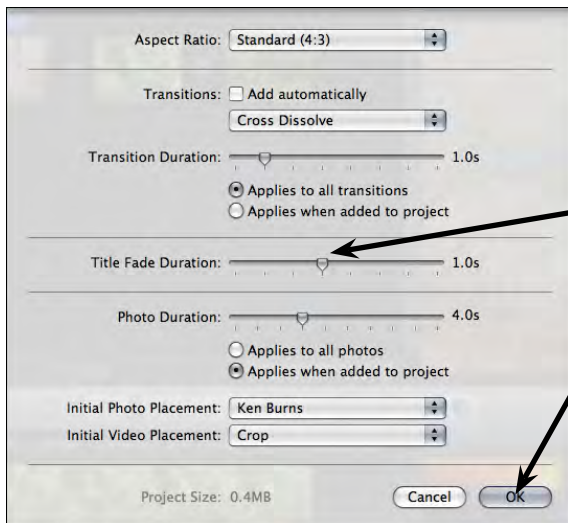
1 Move the pointer over the left edge of the blue title box until a bar with horizontal arrows appears and drag the edge to the right.

2 Drag the right edge of the title to the left.

Adjusting the Fade

The text is set to take half a second to fade in and half a second to fade out. This can be adjusted.

- 1 Display the FILE menu and select PROJECT PREFERENCES.



2 Drag the TITLE FADE DURATION bar to 1 second to increase the fade times and select OK.

- 3 Click on the PLAY PROJECT FROM BEGINNING button at the base of the PROJECT LIBRARY pane to see the effect of the changes.
