
More Detailed Charts


Microsoft Excel allows you to create more detailed charts. To do this a larger spreadsheet will need to be opened.


- 1 Load Microsoft Exce and click on the OPEN icon in the QUICK ACCESS TOOLBAR or from within the FILE tab or FILE menu.
- 2 Access the EXCEL 2019 SUPPORT FILES folder and open the CHAPTER 8 folder.
- 3 Open the EXPENSES2 template, selecting YES to the READ-ONLY dialogue box.

Recommending a Chart


Microsoft Excel can recommend possible charts to suit the data you are plotting.








- 4 Styles can be applied to the chart in different ways:
 - On the Windows system from the DESIGN tab of the CHART TOOLS in the RIBBON or from the CHART STYLES icon next to the chart.
 - On the Macintosh system from the CHART DESIGN tab in the RIBBON.




The Column Chart Options

The COLUMN chart has many more options than the PIE chart. We will look at a few of these new options.

A The Chart Title





B Moving the Legend

The LEGEND would look better at the right of the chart in this case.

- 1 On the Windows system click on the CHART AREA to reselect the chart.
- 2 On the Macintosh system open the CHART DESIGN tab, click on the ADD CHART ELEMENT icon, highlight LEGEND and select RIGHT.
