## The History Panel and History Brush

The HISTORY panel is a valuable asset in the development of a product. It records the steps that you carry out in a session. Each step is called a STATE. You can return to states, save a snapshot at a certain position, save a file at a certain position and so forth.


### **Using the History Panel**

To demonstrate how to use the HISTORY panel, a photo will be opened, some edits made to it then the HISTORY panel used to manage those edits.

#### A Loading the Sample Photo

- 1 Load Photoshop or close the current files and select OPEN from the FILE menu.
- 2 Access the PScs5 SUPPORT FILES, open the CHAPTER 38 folder and open the file:


